

## Correction to “A Pliocene-Pleistocene stack of 57 globally distributed benthic $\delta^{18}\text{O}$ records”

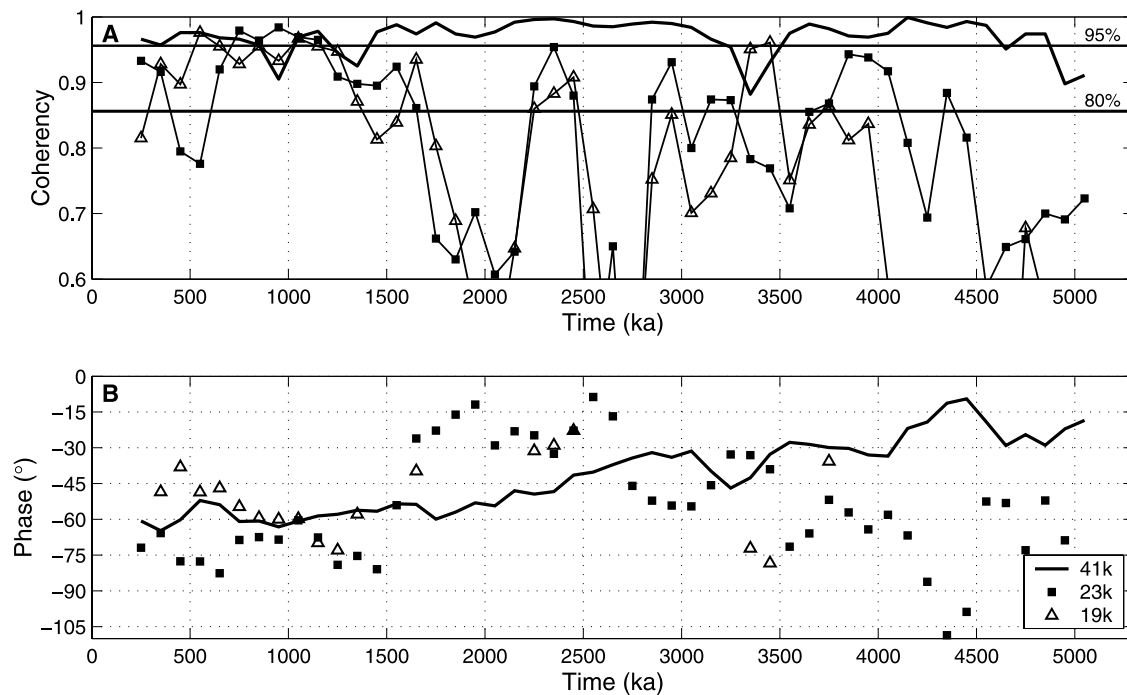
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[1] In the paper “A Pliocene-Pleistocene stack of 57 globally distributed benthic  $\delta^{18}\text{O}$  records” by Lorraine E. Lisiecki and Maureen E. Raymo (*Paleoceanography*, 20, PA1003, doi:10.1029/2004PA001071, 2005), the precession

phases of the stack relative to June 21 insolation were incorrect in Figure 7. The correctly plotted figure is given here. All of the phase values provided in the text of the original article were correct.
